A peaceful loop through towering sequoias with historic sites and interpretive signs along the way.

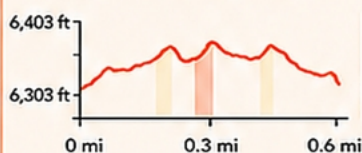

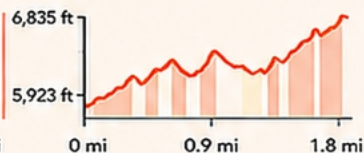
