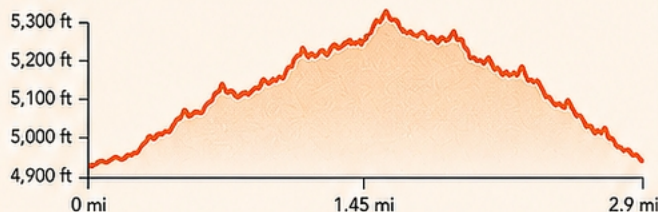

FACILITIES

- Restrooms at each day use area.
- Picnic tables and charcoal grills at Powder Can.
- Interpretive signs along the trail.



ACTIVITIES

- Swimming, fishing (trout), picnicking, birding, and non-motorized boating (kayaks, canoes). Boat rentals and a restaurant at Hume Christian Camp (open to the public).



DOGS

- Permitted on the trail with a leash.
