FACILITIES

Cafés and restaurants line the route. Public restrooms near the market may cost 1–2 soles. Carry toilet paper and hand sanitizer.



WATER AVAILABILITY

Bottled water is sold at tiendas and cafés throughout the walk.



CELL SERVICE

Excellent 4G/5G coverage throughout the town center.



DOGS

Allowed. Expect free-roaming community dogs. Keep pets on a short leash.



ACCESSIBILITY

Mostly accessible, but narrow sidewalks and uneven cobblestones require caution.



WHAT TO BRING

- Small-denomination soles
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Light jacket
- Reusable shopping bag



MARKET TIP

Open year-round. Sunday is the liveliest day; Tuesday and Thursday are also popular. On Sunday, arrive by mid-morning for the best chance of seeing the procession to San Pedro Apóstol.



ALTITUDE NOTE

Pisac sits at 2,970 m (9,744 ft). Walk slowly and stay hydrated.
