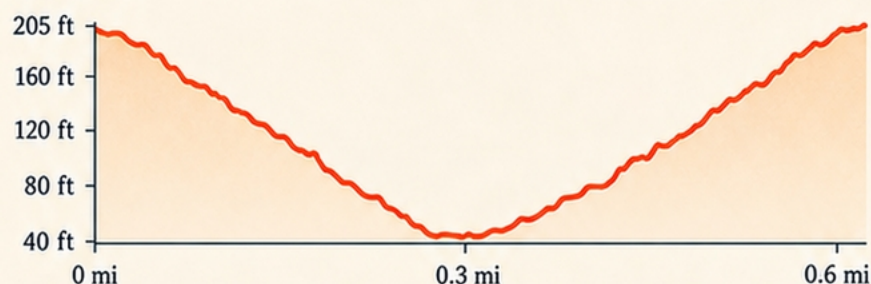

QUICK TRAIL NOTES



TRAILHEAD:

46701 Historic Columbia River Hwy, Corbett, OR 97019



ACCESSIBILITY:

Falls trail has a steep descent, gravel, and stairs; not wheelchair or stroller accessible. Adjacent Overlook Loop is paved and accessible.



FACILITIES:

Restrooms, picnic tables, lawn, and paved parking lot.



WATER:

No potable water. Bring your own.



CELL SERVICE:

Weak or unreliable. Download maps before arriving.



SEASON:

Open year-round. Ice is possible in winter.



PARKING:

About 22 spaces. Arrive early or late on weekends.



DOGS:

Allowed on leash.



COST:

Day-use parking permit required.



WHAT TO BRING:

Traction shoes, water, a light layer, and a camera.
