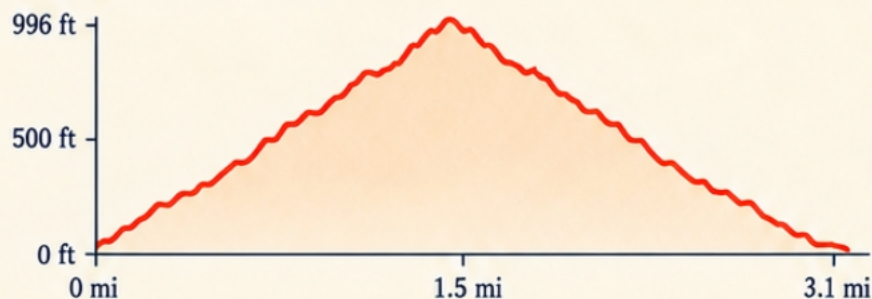

QUICK TRAIL NOTES



TRAILHEAD:

Historic Columbia River Hwy,
just west of Multnomah Falls.



ACCESSIBILITY:

Lower overlook accessible.
Upper trail is steep, narrow,
and unpaved.



FACILITIES:

Restrooms, picnic tables,
and shelter across the highway.



WATER:

No dependable potable water.
Bring your own.



CELL SERVICE:

Spotty. Download maps
before arriving.



SEASON:

Open year-round. Ice and
storm debris are possible.



PARKING:

Small lots. Arrive early
on weekends.



DOGS:

Allowed on a leash
up to 6 feet.



COST:

Free. No parking pass
required.



WHAT TO BRING:

Traction shoes, water, offline
map, light rain layer, and
sun protection.
